

MetroTech Area Business Improvement District Public Safety Officer

ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND

MetroTech Public Safety is an unarmed security force conducting exterior security patrols, on foot within a twenty-seven (27) square block area in downtown Brooklyn. Our organization was established to enhance the safety of the public and the protection of property within the MetroTech BID. The resources and activities of the MetroTech BID Public Safety Program are designed to supplement, not replace, the basic protective and response services of the New York City Police Department.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Public Safety Officer's primary objectives are crime prevention, protection of people and property, the discouragement of unacceptable behavior, and the reporting of offenses, hazards and conditions to the appropriate law enforcement and governmental agencies. The extent to which these objectives are accomplished by deterrence, observation, recording, and reporting is directly proportional to the safety of the citizens living, working, shopping, and visiting within the MetroTech BID area.

Our members must be capable to be licensed as a New York State Security Guard and maintain a valid New York State security license. This is required by New York State law. Our members must meet the following minimum requirements prior to interviewing with us:

- 21 years of age
- United States Citizen
- 1 year security experience (negotiable) or prior military service with an honorable discharge.
- High school diploma or GED (ONLINE GEDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED)

COMPENSATION

- Starting salary is \$20.00/hour
- Holiday premium pay
- Comprehensive benefits package including medical, vision, and dental coverage, paid vacation and sick leave, employer sponsored life insurance policy, pre-tax 403b retirement plan.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Our officers perform duty around the clock and seven (7) days a week. Because of this we will not guarantee our members shift schedules or regular days off. However, we have no split shifts and no split days off.

Shift schedules are listed below:

• DAY SHIFT: 6:30 AM-3 P.M.

AFTERNOON SHIFT: 2:30 PM TO 11 PM

NIGHT SHIFT 10:30 PM- 7 AM.

During our members 1st month there is a paid training period where they must perform duty on one week of each of the above shifts. They will then be assigned to a regular shift with regular days off.

We make all supervisory promotions from within our organization.

New employees are trained by our most experienced officers.

We provide all members uniforms and provide for the upkeep of the uniforms at no cost to the members.
